



HEAP Helps.

If you need help paying your heating bills, the Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP), a federally funded program, may be a solution. Income guidelines have changed and more people than ever can now qualify for a Regular grant. **HEAP funding is limited, so applying early is critical.**

Gross Annual Income Guidelines:

<u>Household Size</u>	<u>Maximum Income</u>
1	\$24,355
2	\$31,849
3	\$39,343
4	\$46,837
5	\$54,330
6	\$61,824

HEAP eligibility is determined using the last four weeks of your household income.

Emergency grants are available to customers who have had their utility service shut off, or are facing disconnection because of unpaid bills and do not have available resources to pay the shut-off amount.



Applying for help with your heating costs has never been easier!

Depending on your circumstances, you may apply:

- **By mail** – Customers who received a Regular HEAP grant last year and still reside in the same county can now apply by mail for a 2009-2010 HEAP Regular grant.
- **In person** – Applications are taken at all local county Social Services offices and designated satellite sites.
- **By telephone** - For HEAP Emergency grants, contact a local Social Services office in your county of residence.
