Empire Pipeline, Inc. (Empire), a subsidiary of National Fuel Gas Company, plans to file an application with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC) for the Empire North Project. If approved, the proposed natural gas infrastructure project will transport regionally produced natural gas into the interstate natural gas pipeline system to provide reliable supplies of energy to local Western New York gas distribution utilities and market centers in the northeastern United States via the North American Pipeline grid.

The project includes construction and operation of a 22,214 HP Turbine Driven Compressor Station in Jackson Township, Tioga County, Pa. The station will be located on a 33.2 acre parcel off Buckwheat Hollow Rd and Stateline Rd adjacent to existing natural gas infrastructure, and will include modifications to Empire's existing Jackson Meter & Regulator Station at that same location.

We plan to submit a formal application to FERC in January 2018 with a target in-service date of November 2019.

You are being contacted because your property is located within 0.5 miles of the construction area for the proposed facilities. We want to provide you with as much information as possible about the project and your rights as a landowner. To that end, we'd like to invite you to attend an information session where National Fuel representatives will be present to answer questions, give a project and company overview while providing detailed maps of the proposed project.
